Our children love learning and we are looking to find staff who will work closely with teachers to get to know the children, giving energy and commitment to each child to help them to reach their full potential and feel good about their strengths.

We hope to find staff with the ability to calm and nurture children, providing positive behaviour management, emotional support and encouraging their wellbeing.

Confidence in the application of English and Maths skills will be needed to support children of all abilities. We can support the successful candidate to develop curriculum knowledge, however a good basic knowledge of the National Curriculum and/or Early Years curriculum will be very useful.

An understanding or experience of working with children with SEND would be an advantage. All of our support staff roles include working inclusively and flexibly to provide the whole class, small group or individual support in partnership with class teachers.

We believe in professional development for all staff and our support staff have been involved in a range of training opportunities over the last year including attachment-based mentoring and precision teaching. You will also have the opportunity to work collaboratively with teachers and other teaching assistants across the school to develop your professional practice.

Ide school are part of the Exeter Learning Academy Trust and the successful candidate will benefit from the training and opportunities from shared work and development across our schools which we offer as a trust.

Although we are a relatively small school, we like to keep at the forefront of curriculum development and give our children the most exciting opportunities possible on a local and national scale; this year we achieved the "Gold" school games award, performed Henry V at the Phoenix in Exeter as part of the National Schools' Shakespeare and our work has been chosen for display at the National Gallery in London as part of "Take one Picture" project 2020 – 2021.
